- Show the cover of the book and read its title aloud. Ask, "What helps a plant grow?"
- Give the child a silk (or real) flower to hold as they share their ideas. Ask questions that encourage them to use weatherrelated words: hot, dry, rain, cold.
- Read the story aloud and invite child to tap the book with their flower before turning the page.
